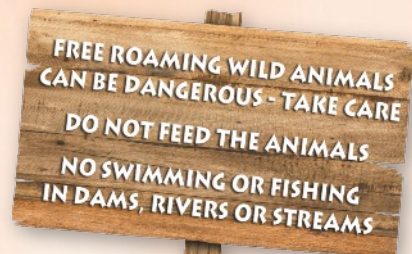
Reserve Rules and Safety

Welcome to Mabalingwe - Below the most important rules to ensure peaceful co-habitation between game, visitors and owners.

- 1) **Speed Limit** – For the safety of the game limit your speed and adhere to the posted speed limits. Vehicles can only be driven by persons holding a valid drivers licence.
- 2) **Noise** – Noise travels far in the open area and must be kept to a minimum at all times (no loud music ever!) with no noise after 10pm.
- 3) **Fires and wood** – Dead wood in nature serves an important ecological purpose and may not be collected from any part of the reserve. Uncontrolled veld fires pose a danger to life and limb for game and owners. Fires may only be lit in a fire pit / braai area built for the purpose and must be doused and completely extinguished before retiring for the night. Be especially careful with fires during windy periods.

If you notice a veld or uncontrolled fire, please immediately call the Control Room.

- 4) **Restricted areas** – please respect the no entry and restricted areas of the reserve – certain areas are restricted to Mabalingwe-registered green game drive vehicles – no other type of vehicle is allowed to traverse these areas.
- 5) **Firearms and Drones** - The use of any firearm, air rifle, pistol, gas-propelled or powered arms, bow and arrow, slingshot, fireworks or any other potentially hazardous or dangerous weapon is strictly prohibited. The flying of drones and use of lazars are prohibited.
- 6) **Pets and animals** - No domesticated pets, animals, birds, reptiles, insects or fish may be brought onto Mabalingwe. No game (including fish or any form of wildlife) may be sold, hunted, culled, captured or shot.
- 7) **Security** – please don't be lulled by the serene atmosphere of the reserve – there are instances of petty theft and burglary. You are requested to ensure that all windows and doors are securely locked at night or when the house is unoccupied. Valuables should be locked away and not left in plain sight.

Recycling Programme

All guests, visitors and owners are asked to help us protect the environment by joining our recycling programme.

Please place all tins, bottles, glass, paper, cardboard and plastic into a green bin bag and all other household waste into a black bin bag.

Please note that only household waste can be disposed of on the Greater Mabalalingwe - any items not considered usual household waste, including building rubble and appliances, must be removed from the property.

Please don't discard any item (including apple cores and banana skins) into the bush.
